DR NAVI PILLAY is a South African jurist who served as the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights from 2008 to 2014, Judge of the International Criminal Court and President of the International Criminal Tribunal for Rwanda. In 2021, Dr Pillay was appointed as the chairperson of the United Nations Independent International Commission of Inquiry on the Occupied Palestinian Territory, including East Jerusalem, and Israel.



PROFESSOR JOHN DUGARD SC is Professor Emeritus of the Universities of the Witwatersrand and Leiden, former UN Special Rapporteur on the Human Rights Situation in the Occupied Palestinian Territories, member of International Law Commission and ad hoc Judge of the International Court of Justice.



PROFESSOR MAX DU PLESSIS SC is an International Lawyer with chambers in Durban and London, who has been involved in cases before the International Criminal Court, the African Commission on Human and Peoples Rights, the US Supreme Court and the Israeli Supreme Court.
